
Mila and Victoria Room 13, Grade 2

We are learning about money. We are reading <u>Superfudge</u>. We are doing problem solving. We are learning about do not go outside without your jacket!







Casey, Noah, Harley, Andrea Room 21, Grade 4

Aden, Steph, and Ruby Room 25, Grade 4



Rene and Chloe Room 1, Grades 4 & 5


In class we are learning to do all bout books. We celebrated Albert's birthday last Friday. We're having lunch helpers next Monday.
