# Hannah and Sean Rooms 3&4, Kindergarten


This Monday, on the 100th day, we made 100 necklaces, we wrote 100, and we made a 100 snack.


We learned about wood. We had to smell and feel wood. We made things and painted them. We dyed the wood in colors.


# Kayla and Mitchell Room 14, Grade 2
