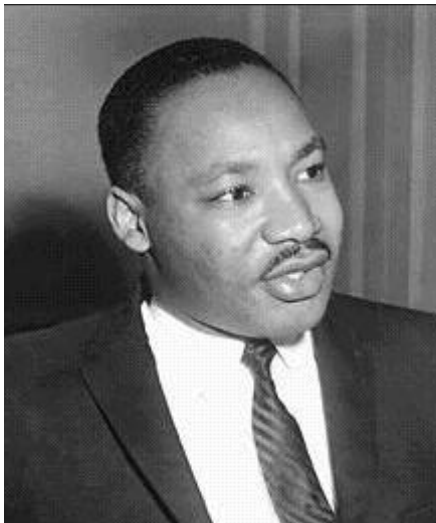

Our author of the month is Leo Lionni. Our favorite book that he wrote is Swimming.

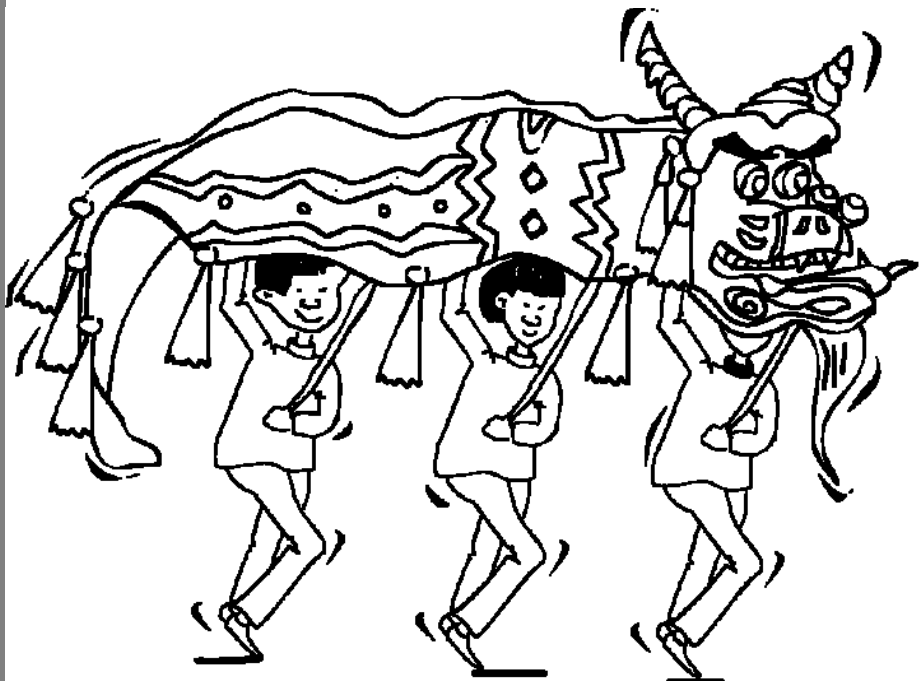
**Hiep and Jaelynn

not be treated good!

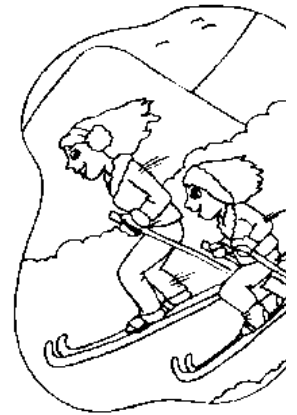
