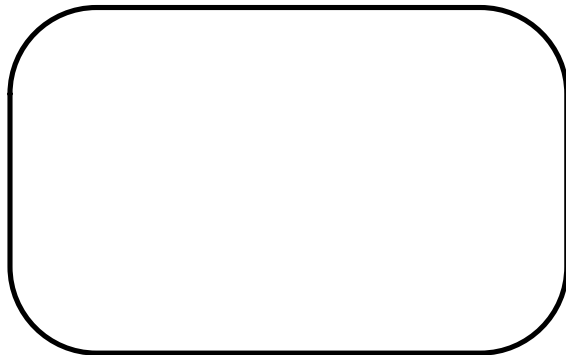
This is a picture of the nesting box of Mae, the peregrine falcon. How many eggs do you see right now? \_\_\_\_\_
